Peace Student Receives Outstanding Senior in French Award

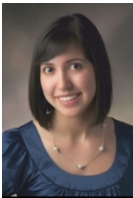
Queen of Peace senior Julia Amador recently received a 2009-10 American Association of Teachers of French (AATF) Outstanding Senior in French Award. This award is given annually to a graduating senior who has demonstrated excellence in the study of French as well as exceptional commitment to the French language and many cultures where it is spoken, completed at least three years of French study at the time of graduation, and is a non-native French speaker.

Julia – a four-year student of French - is president of Peace's chapter of the French National Honor Society. She participated in the National French Contest this year and in 2009 traveled to France, where she stayed with a host family for 10 days, experienced the French culture first-hand and practiced her French speaking skills.

The AATF was founded in 1927 and is the largest professional association of French teachers in the world with nearly 10,000 members.
