**Queen of Peace Hosts CMLS Contest**

Over 400 students, teachers and judges attended the Catholic Math League South Contest at Queen of Peace High School on Saturday, Dec. 4. The contest featured 13 competitions, including four individual competitions (Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra II and Pre-Calculus), seven team competitions (Calculators, Fr/So 2-person, Fr/So 8-person, Jr/Sr 2-person, Jr/Sr 8-person, Fr/So Relay and Jr/Sr Relay) and two Oral Competitions.

Sixty members of Queen of Peace's Math Team, which is coached by math teacher Judy Canning, competed at the contest. Peace's leading scorers were senior Erin Kolasinki, junior Kelly Kennedy, sophomore Hannah Lipman and frosh Ryunhyo Park.
