



# Queen of Peace High School Criteria for Scholarships and Grants

## CURRENT STUDENTS

Due to the generosity of alumnae, friends and foundations, Queen of Peace High School is able to offer the following scholarships and financial need-based grants to **current students**. In order to apply for the following, students must be registered at Queen of Peace High School for the 2010-2011 year and submit the required materials indicated below by **Wednesday, March 31, 2010**. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

### Service & Leadership Award *(NON-RENEWABLE)*

Applicant must:

1. Demonstrate service and leadership in her school, parish and/or community
2. Be a current student in good standing
3. Have not received this award in the past
4. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.25
5. Complete the application form
6. Attach an essay describing your service and examples of your leadership role in that service activity - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE.
7. Attach two recommendations from church leaders, community members or a teacher describing your involvement in service or ministry.
  - No more than one recommendation may come from a teacher.
  - Church leaders or community members must have known you for two or more years.

### Franklin-Strobel Grant *(NON-RENEWABLE NEED BASED)*

Applicant must:

1. Demonstrate exemplary performance in English or foreign language class and have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
2. Be a current student in good standing
3. Have not received this award in the past
4. Express financial need by having completed the PSAS Form
5. Complete the application form
6. Attach a statement or essay describing your appreciation of the languages (including foreign languages if applicable) and how they have made a difference in your life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE.

## **Sinsinawa Dominican Award** *(NON-RENEWABLE)*

Applicant must:

1. Demonstrate commitment to the Dominican values of Truth, Justice, Compassion, Partnership and Community.
2. Be a current student in good standing
3. Have not received this award in the past
4. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
5. Complete the application form
6. Attach two recommendations – one from a Queen of Peace faculty member and one from a member of your church or community who has known you for two or more years.
7. Attach an essay describing how you have demonstrated your commitment to the Dominican values and how those values have made a difference in your life  
- NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE.

## **Barbara Sheehy, O.P. Grant** *(NON-RENEWABLE NEED BASED)*

Applicant must:

1. Demonstrate exemplary service or ministry in school or the community
2. Be a current student in good standing
3. Have not received this award in the past
4. Express financial need by having completed the PSAS Form
5. Complete the application form
6. Attach two recommendations from church leaders, community members or a teacher describing your involvement in service or ministry.
  - ❑ No more than one recommendation may come from a teacher.
  - ❑ Church leaders or community members must have known you for two or more years.
7. Attach an essay describing how you have demonstrated your involvement in service or ministry in school or the community and how this service or ministry has made a difference in your life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE

## Mrozek Scholarship (NON-RENEWABLE)

Only current 2009-2010 third-year students may apply.

Applicant must:

1. Be a 2010-2011 senior student involved in a music program
2. Be in good standing
3. Complete the application form
4. Attach two recommendations - one from a teacher and one from a community member describing your commitment to a music program (*Church leaders or community members must have known you for two or more years.*)
5. Attach an essay describing your commitment to music and how music has made a difference in your life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE.

## Family Discounts

A **\$1,000** discount is given to families with two daughters attending QOP.

A **\$2,000** discount is given to families with three daughters attending QOP.

If a brother attends St. Laurence, there is a tuition discount of **\$750**. St. Laurence and Queen of Peace will each give a **\$375** reduction while both students are attending.

## To apply for a *Financial Need-Based Grant*, follow the directions below.

- Student must be registered for the 2010-2011 school year.
- \$250 registration fee must be paid.
- Families must demonstrate financial need by having completed a 2010-2011 **PSAS Form**. (PSAS Forms are available in the Queen of Peace Tuition Office).
- *PSAS Forms* must be completed and post-marked no later than **March 31, 2010**.
- All *PSAS* applicants will be considered.
- Families will be notified in July if they are eligible to receive financial assistance from Queen of Peace.
