



Queen of Peace High School Criteria for Scholarships and Grants

CURRENT STUDENTS

Due to the generosity of alumnae, friends and foundations, Queen of Peace High School is able to offer the following scholarships and financial need based grants to **current students**. To apply for the following, students must be registered at Queen of Peace High School for the 2011-2012 school year and submit the required materials indicated below by **Tuesday, March 22, 2011**. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Service & Leadership Award *(NON-RENEWABLE)*

Applicant must:

1. demonstrate service and leadership in her school, parish and/or community
2. be a current student in good standing
3. not have received this award in the past
4. have a cumulative GPA of 3.25
5. complete the application form
6. attach an essay describing her service and examples of her leadership role in that service activity - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE
7. attach two recommendations from church leaders, community members or a teacher describing her involvement in service or ministry
 - No more than one recommendation may come from a teacher.
 - Church leaders or community members must have known the applicant for two or more years.

Franklin-Strobel Grant *(NON-RENEWABLE NEED BASED)*

Applicant must:

1. demonstrate exemplary performance in English or foreign language class and have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
2. be a current student in good standing
3. not have received this award in the past
4. demonstrate financial need by completing and submitting a PSAS form
5. complete application form
6. attach a statement or essay describing her appreciation of the languages (including foreign languages if applicable) and how they have made a difference in her life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE

Sinsinawa Dominican Award *(NON-RENEWABLE)*

Applicant must:

1. demonstrate commitment to the Dominican values of justice, compassion, truth, partnership and community
2. be a current student in good standing
3. not have received this award in the past
4. have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
5. complete application form
6. attach two recommendations – one from a Queen of Peace faculty member and one from a member of her church or community who has known the applicant for two or more years
7. attach an essay describing how she has demonstrated her commitment to the Dominican values and how those values have made a difference in her life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE

Barbara Sheehy, O.P. Grant *(NON-RENEWABLE NEED BASED)*

Applicant must:

1. provide evidence of exemplary service or ministry in school or the community
2. be a current student in good standing
3. not have received this award in the past
4. demonstrate financial need by completing and submitting a PSAS Form
5. complete the application form
6. attach two recommendations from church leaders, community members or a teacher describing her involvement in service or ministry
 - ❑ No more than one recommendation may come from a teacher.
 - ❑ Church leaders or community members must have known the applicant for two or more years.
7. attach an essay describing how she has demonstrated her involvement in service or ministry in school or the community and how this service or ministry has made a difference in her life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE

Mrozek Scholarship (NON-RENEWABLE)

Only current 2010-2011 third-year students may apply.

Applicant must:

1. be a 2011-2012 senior student involved in a music program
2. be in good standing
3. complete the application form
4. attach two recommendations - one from a teacher and one from a community member describing the student's commitment to a music program (*Church leaders or community members must have known the student for two or more years.*)
5. attach an essay describing the student's commitment to music and how music has made a difference in her life - NO MORE THAN ONE DOUBLE-SPACED TYPEWRITTEN PAGE

Family Discounts

A **\$1000** discount is given to families with two daughters attending QOP.

A **\$2000** discount is given to families with three daughters attending QOP.

If a brother attends St. Laurence, there is a tuition discount of **\$750**. St. Laurence and Queen of Peace will each give a **\$375** reduction while both students are attending.

To apply for a *Financial Need Based Grant* follow the directions below.

- Student must be registered for the 2011-2012 school year.
- \$250 registration fee must be paid.
- Families must demonstrate financial need by completing and submitting a 2011-2012 **PSAS Form**. (PSAS Forms are available in the Queen of Peace Tuition Office.)
- *PSAS Forms* must be completed and post marked no later than **March 22, 2011**.
- All *PSAS* applicants will be considered.
- *Families will be notified in **June or July** if they are eligible to receive financial assistance from Queen of Peace.*
