### **Peace Holds Haiti Prayer Service**

Queen of Peace held a community prayer service Tuesday, Jan. 19 for the victims, families and relief workers of the recent Haitian earthquake. The entire student body sat in a circular formation and first watched a news video about the devastation in Haiti and then reflected on the promise of hope in the world.

“We hold in our hearts our sisters and brothers affected by the disaster in Haiti, especially those who lost their lives,” said campus minister Kathleen Greenan.

Through Operation Rice Bowl, Peace, which continuously incorporates global consciousness into its curriculum, is raising money school-wide to aid Catholic Relief Services with their efforts in Haiti. The collection by Peace students, faculty and staff will culminate with the conclusion of Catholic Schools Week on Jan. 29. Peace also is planning a number of other events to increase awareness of Haiti and to illustrate the magnitude of the tragedy, such as using kernels of corn in a display in the cafeteria to represent each life lost in the earthquake.
