Fair Trade refers to product distribution systems which are designed to assure that farmers and artisans in developing countries receive a fair price for their products – as opposed to the usual global distribution system wherein most of the profits go to wholesalers and distributors. Fair Trade cooperatives formed in developing countries to bring individual artisans and farmers together, accumulate their produce and products, and distribute them by charging only what is necessary to get the product to market.

Food for thought, literally!

Think of the coffee we all buy at the supermarket. Under the usual system, a coffee farmer will receive only 3% of the \$5-\$7 you might pay for a pound of coffee; on the other hand, the farmer will receive 14% of what you pay for a pound of Fair Trade coffee.
