

QUEEN OF PEACE HIGH SCHOOL HEALTH EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

The Illinois School Code Section 665.120 requires all incoming high school students to have a physical examination plus the required immunizations completed and up to date prior to the first day of school. Incoming FROSH may use their Certificate of Child Health Examination form as their freshman sports physical.

THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE OF CHILD HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM IS DUE MAY 20TH 2009

Diphtheria, Pertussis and Tetanus (DPT) – three or more doses including a booster after the 4th birthday.

Oral Polio (OPV) – Three or more doses including a booster after 4th birthday.

Diphtheria and Tetanus (Td) - If 10 years have elapsed since the last DPT or Td, a Td booster is required.

Mumps – Vaccine at 12 months or older.

Measles (Rubeola) – Two doses of the live measles vaccine are required with the first at 12 months of age or older.

Hepatitis B – All students in PreK, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grades are required to have proof of a completed 3 dose series with appropriate spacing between each dose.

Dates (month, day and year) of ALL immunizations must be included on the health exam form and verified by a physician or health care provider.

The student information and medical health history sections of the form **MUST** be fully completed and signed by the parent or legal guardian.

Please do not submit out dated physicals. Retain grade school physicals for your records.

Medical forms are due on May 20th 2009. Forms may be mailed in or dropped off. Do not fax forms as the **original** form is required. Remember to make a copy to retain for your records.

All out of state or out of country transfer students must present a current health exam which has been completed within one calendar year of current school year. The transferring health/physical exam **MUST** also include the dates of all immunizations since birth. Students attending school in Illinois must show proof of immunity for all required immunizations. (Please take note of the above Illinois School Code schedule information for required immunizations) All records must be submitted within 30 days of enrollment. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in the student being excluded from school.

Physical exams are available at Saint Xavier University Health Center for a reasonable cost. (773) 298-3712.
